When Fred Moyer and his friends placed their sign at the four corners it was during Canada's Centennial year of 1967. The population of Port Maitland was 112 inhabitants. The home computer was not even a possibility. Facts that are available on the web today were not available then. Fred did a great job of giving our little hamlet a sense of history and pride in our community.

Today with the advantage of computers we have learned a bit more than Fred could have known.

The first version is 11 by 14 inches with a half inch border for framing. **We are selling them for \$50.00 plus shipping.**

The second version is a limited edition print with the artist's signature. These prints will be larger (approximately 12 by 16 inches) also with a margin for the signature and mounting. The number of prints to be sold will be determined by the number purchased by late spring of 2023 (approximately May 31<sup>st</sup>). Once we know the number we will have them printed and signed. **The cost of this print will be \$75.00 plus shipping.** If you wish to purchase this option we **will need a deposit of \$35.00** before we can order the print. The remaining funds will be collected when delivery is available.
